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Anders L. Carlson, MD, is an adult endocrinologist and Associate Executive Director at the International Diabetes Center at HealthPartners in Minneapolis, MN. He is also an Associate Professor at the University of Minnesota Medical School and is a member of the American Diabetes Association, Endocrine Society and American Association of Clinical Endocrinologists.

Dr. Carlson received his MD from the University of Minnesota Medical School. He completed his internal medicine residency at Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis, MN. He trained in endocrinology and diabetes at the University of Vermont in Burlington, VT.

His current research efforts are centered on diabetes technology, prevention and education. He is a principal investigator on several clinical trials looking at new diabetes therapeutics as well as devices such as automated insulin delivery systems and continuous glucose monitoring in special populations, including pregnancy. He has been a co-investigator on several NIH funded studies, including EDIC, GRADE and FLAIR. In conjunction with the team at the International Diabetes Center, he has published several articles about glucose data interpretation and use of the Ambulatory Glucose Profile (AGP).
