The OhioHealth Wellness Diabetes Management Program helps participants understand and better manage their condition to live a healthier lifestyle.

The OhioHealth Wellness Diabetes Management Program provides education, support and access to clinicians (pharmacists, nurses, dietitians and independent licensed social workers) to help participants better manage their overall health. This program is available to OhioHealth associates, spouses and dependents currently enrolled in the OhioHealth Associate Health Plan offered through the OhioHealthy Medical Plan. Active participants receive discounts for diabetes medications and supplies through OhioHealth's outpatient pharmacy.

Benefits of participation include decreased blood sugar (individualized), preventing disease progression, and improving patient access and adherence to medications.

Eligibility is easy!

To be eligible for the Diabetes Management Program, participants must:

- Be an OhioHealthy Medical Plan member through OhioHealth with a diagnosis of diabetes
- Complete telehealth appointments with a pharmacist
- Review your personalized care plan
- Be an active participant in the management of your care

Help with medication costs

As a Diabetes Management Program participant, once your deductible is met, the plan will cover formulary medications for diabetes at 100% of the cost.* Please note that until your deductible has been met, you are responsible for all medical and drug expenses.

Your medication must be filled through an OhioHealth pharmacy. Pharmacy locations include the New Albany Medical Campus, Marion General Hospital, Pickerington Methodist Hospital and Riverside Methodist Hospital.
